After the Presidents presentations, and bell ringing, there will be panels with Ministers of Finance, Ministers of Foreign Trade, Central Bank Governors and Chairmen and CEOs of some of the most important multilateral companies from the Alliance.

This Pacific Alliance-focused conference, with the participation of public and private sector representatives, will be complemented with **one-on-one meetings** and a **Financial Times Special Report that will be published worldwide** in the print and on-line editions.
