## TPP11: An overview and trade benefits

- Accession to TPP11 would deepen the UK's access to fast-growing markets and major economies of the future, including Chile, Mexico and Malaysia
- TPP11 accounts for 13% of global GDP in 2019 - GDP would rise to 16% following the UK's accession
- 99.9% of all the goods we export to TPP11 members will have tariffs eliminated, opening new opportunities for goods such as cars, whisky distillers and machinery to half a billion consumers
- TPP11 has better provisions in many areas than the existing UK-Chile trade agreement, including in intellectual property protection and digital trade
- The UK joining TPP11 also allows Chile and the UK to improve their access to each other's markets – in goods, services and ability to compete for government contracts
