


# 3. Trade Briefing 2022

#### Chile's main exported products to Indonesia 2022


Millions US\$ and percentages

## 3. Halal Certification

Indonesia's Law No.31: imported Halal products must be certified by the Halal Product Assurance Organizing Body (BPJPH)

Chile is the 1st Latinamerican country in signing a MoU in Halal Cooperation (2020)

"Chile Halal" and "Centro Islámico de Chile" are working to be recognized as Halal certifying companies to certify chilean exporters
